7.2 APPEARANCE EXPECTATIONS

Our exterior appearance gives witness to who we are in Christ. Our appearance is to be pleasing to the Lord every day. Parents are responsible for enforcing the expectations with their children. This expectation applies to all ORLS-sponsored activities, on and off-campus. The two guidelines for dress are simple: Dress appropriately and modestly. Dress safely. Please help our students dress appropriately, modestly, and safely.

Dress appropriately and modestly: As we seek to maintain an atmosphere that glorifies God and promotes learning, we require students to avoid the following:

- Extremes in makeup, dress, hairstyle, or hair color that draw attention to the student or becomes disruptive to the school environment
- Hair color other than a natural color
- Clothing with content related to immoral themes
- Tattered, torn, excessively frayed, or dirty clothing
- Excessively baggy, excessively tight-fitting, or low-hanging pants
- Shorts, skirts, or dresses not of a modest length
- Clothes that do not cover undergarments or midriff
- Indoor head coverings: hats, caps, hoods, sunglasses
- Sleeveless shirts
- Shoes without backs.

Dress Safely: Students should wear clothing and footwear that is safe and appropriate for recess, play, and physical education. Please avoid the following:

- Bare feet, flip-flops, high heels, or other footwear that can easily come off the foot while running or playing
- Watches, earrings, necklaces, and other loose or potentially dangerous items should be removed before
 physical education.
- Shorts from December to February, shorts may be worn from March 1 to November 30.

Children who do not follow the expectations will be required to change and may be given appropriate clothing to wear. That clothing must be washed and returned to school. Special exceptions to the appearance expectations are allowed during spirit week. Fashions change often, and the dress code may need to change, but the pertinent guideline will always be to dress in a way that brings glory to the Lord (1 Corinthians 10:31).
